1. CAT Team Staffing Req 01 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 1.0 FTE Team Leader: (A) Master degree in Behavioral Health Sciences; (B) active license issued by Florida Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage & Family Therapy and Mental Health Counseling; (C) min 3 years experience working with children or adolescents with behavioral health needs.
2. CAT Team Staffing Req 02 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) Team leader Training: Does staff in this position have received supplemental topic-specific training in family systems, crisis intervention, teenager or young adult suicide prevention and trauma informed care.
3. CAT Team Staffing Req 03 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) Team leader Training: Does the NSP ensure staff have received supplemental topic-specific training in co-occurring substance and mental health disorders and treatment.
4. CAT Team Staffing Req 04 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 2.0 FTE Mental Health Clinicians: (A) a Master degree in Behavioral Health Sciences, such as mental health counseling, social work, art therapy or marriage and family therapy; (B) a minimum of two years of experience working with children or adolescents with behavioral health needs.
5. CAT Team Staffing Req 05 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) Mental Health Clinician Training: Does the NSP ensure staff in this position have received supplemental topic-specific training in family systems, crisis intervention, teenager or young adult suicide prevention and trauma informed care.
6. CAT Team Staffing Req 06 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) Mental Health Clinician Training: Does the NSP ensure staff in this position have received supplemental topic specific training in co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorders and treatment.
7. CAT Team Staffing Req 07 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 1.0 FTE Case Manager: (A) a Bachelor's degree with a major in counseling, social work, psychology, criminal justice, nursing rehabilitation, special education, or related fields; (B) minimum of 1 year experience working with children or adolescents [or] a Bachelor's degree in any other field and a minimum of 3 years of experience with children with serious emotional disturbances.
8. CAT Team Staffing Req 08 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) Case Manager Training: Does the NSP ensure staff in this position have received supplemental topic specific training in family systems, crisis intervention, teenager or young adult suicide prevention and trauma informed care.
9. CAT Team Staffing Req 09 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 3.0 FTE Therapeutic Mentors: (A) Certification as a certified recovery peer specialist certified by the Florida Certification Board; (B) A Bachelor of Arts degree in a social services major (psychology, social work, education, or vocation rehabilitation); (C) minimum 1 year experience working directly with children or adolescents with behavioral health needs.
10. CAT Team Staffing Req 10 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 0.25 FTE Psychiatrist or Advance Registered Nurse Practitioner: An active license issued by the Florida Board of Medicine or the Florida Board of Nursing, as appropriate to the individual's specific profession.
11. CAT Team Staffing Req 11 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 0.5 FTE Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse: An active license issued by the Florida Board of Medicine or the Florida Board of Nursing, as appropriate to the individual's specific profession.



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12. CAT Team Staffing Req 12 (LSF Standard Contract, Attachment Community Action Team) 1.0 FTE Support Staff:
Staff assigned to assist the agency CAT Team.
