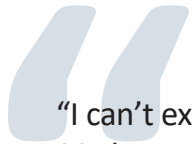

# WHO WE ARE

## LUTHERAN SERVICES FLORIDA

Lutheran Services Florida (LSF) is a non-profit organization transforming lives by ensuring safe children, strong families and vibrant communities. Founded in 1982, LSF currently touches the lives of 1 in 50 Floridians every year through various programs, including early education, youth shelters, foster care, refugee and resettlement services, substance abuse mental health services, and adult guardianship.

LSF helps adolescents live healthier lives and remain out of the juvenile justice system through our prevention and intervention activities. LSF has an estimated 98 percent success rate of youth returning home to their families to rebuild their lives, following their stay at our shelters.

## CHILDREN IN NEED OF SERVICES & FAMILIES IN NEED OF SERVICES (CINS/FINS)

Offers both residential and non-residential crisis counseling services for troubled youth and their families serving all Broward county.

The program provides individual and family counseling. The goal of services is to help resolve conflict and reunite families. LSF's CURRIE HOUSE Youth Shelter offers short-term, residential housing for runaways, homeless, youth experiencing truancy, or ungovernable behaviors in the home. Our youth are ages 10-17.

LSF is a designated Safe Place provider.
